

# 2023 Navajo Nation Farm & Garden Incentive Program



The program offers **active** farmers and gardeners a financial incentive for crop and food production. The AIF supports economic reciprocity among farmers, gardeners, ranchers, and local consumers on the Navajo Nation. Previously funded projects include wind tunnels, hoop houses, apiaries, habitats, gardens, and farm projects.



## Who can apply?

- ◆ All **active** farmers & gardeners on the Navajo Nation
- ◆ Non-profit organizations (EIN # required)

## How to qualify?

- ◆ All agriculture projects must be on the Navajo Nation
- ◆ Identification card/Driver's License
- ◆ Social Security Card
- ◆ Agriculture Land Use Permit (ALUP) if available
- ◆ Returning applicants must submit a 2022 Crop Report
- ◆ **Photos of 2022 garden or farm plot required**
